# **BMO Nations Cup - 1.60M**

#### Scoring:

The Nations' Cup competition is the only team competition in the sport of Show Jumping. Teams from each nation consist of a maximum of four riders and a Chef d'Equipe (team captain). Each member of the team jumps the course - all riders in the first position ride first, then all the riders in the second position ride second, and so on. For each jump knocked down four faults are added to their score, if the horse refuses a jump four faults are also added, if the horse refuses a second time the combination is eliminated. should the horse or rider fall or go off course they are also eliminated. The Course Designer will also set a time allowed that the riders must complete the course in, they are penalise one fault for every four seconds or, part of four seconds over the time allowed. The scores of the best three riders of each team are added together to give the team score. After the first round the best six teams will return for the second round. In case of equality of penalties for 6th place, the times of the best 3 riders on the tied teams will be the deciding factor. In the second round the penalties received by the three best competitors of each team are added to the penalties from the first round. The team with the lowest two round total is the winner. In addition, those teams who are tied with penalties for any place, either after the first or second round, will be placed equal. In the event of equality of faults for first place ONLY, there will be a jump-off with one rider per team participating (selected by the Chef d'Equipe).
